He studied Primary and Secondary Education at the French Lyceum, from which he graduated in 1993, and to which he continues to be linked as President of the French Teaching Society.

A Structural Civil Engineer by profession, he graduated from the Faculty of Engineering of the University of the Republic, 26 years ago he joined Saceem, a company that has led several Engineering and Construction projects in Uruguay and the region.

He joined the company as an Engineer, then he was Site Manager, later he was in charge of the Business Unit of RTI (Networks, Telephony and Information Technology) in Uruguay and Porto Alegre, Brazil, until becoming, in 2008, Commercial Director. Subsequently, he assumed the position of Commercial and Operations Vice President of Saceem, a position he has held since 2011.

From the beginning of his career, Mr. Ruibal was in charge of numerous multidisciplinary teams for important projects such as bridges, high voltage lines, sanitation works and, in recent years, he led projects such as the first UTE Combined Cycle Power Plant, the bridge over Garzón Lagoon, the Champion of the Century Stadium, Montes del Plata and the World Trade Center complex, among others.

He is also Vice President of the French Chamber of Commerce in Montevideo and actively participates in the Construction Chamber of Uruguay in the role of Vice President. He is also founder and Director of the Center for Economic Studies of the Construction Industry and is part of the Board of Directors of Club Atlético Peñarol.
