Born in 1965 in Bad Staffelstein, Germany, Prof. Dr. Hubert Röder is the speaker of the Bavarian Forestry and Wood Industry Cluster since 2016. He is Professor of Sustainable Business Economics at the University of Applied Sciences Weihenstephan-Triesdorf and the Technical University of Munich – TUM Campus Straubing for Biotechnology and Sustainability since 2013 and Lecture at the University of Applied Sciences FH Wiener Neustadt/Austria –Campus Wieselburg about international bioenergy-markets since 2012.

Between 2001 and 2013 he held a position as Senior Consultant and Project Manager at Pöyry Management Consulting in Munich and Viena, leading the BioEnergy und BioValue practice in Central Europe. He was Lecture at Technical University Munich about international forestry and forest Industry (2001 -2007). He performed studies about procurement and supply chain management at BayTech Academy in Munich and University of Applied Sciences in Nuremberg (2002 – 2003) and held leading positions in forestry and forest industry in Germany (1998 – 2001).

He holds a Ph. D degree from the Section of Biometrics and Applied Computer Science at the Faculty of Forest Sciences at the Ludwig Maximilians University Munich/ Germany. [Degree: Dr. rer. silv. (~ PhD), 1993 – 1997] and a Master degree on Forest Sciences from the Faculty of Forest Sciences at the Ludwig Maximilians University Munich/Germany [Degree: Dipl.-Forstwirt (Univ.) (~ MSc. Forestry). 1987 – 1993].

Between 1985 and 1987 he was carpenter apprentice in Bamberg/Germany.
