Dr. Roberto Scoz Director of the National Forest Research Program of the National Institute of Agricultural Research (INIA)

Roberto Scoz is a Forest Engineer graduated from the National University of La Plata (Argentina), did postgraduate studies at the University of Fribourg (Germany), where he obtained his PhD in 2002; the title of his thesis referred to Development in Inventory Methodology for Forest Plantations.

Until 2008 he worked as assistant professor in Forest Biometrics at the same University. In that year he assumed the Direction of the National Program of Investigation in Forest Production of INIA Uruguay being responsible for the scientific activities in this area in that institution.

In this position, he is responsible for the technical assistance in the definition of policies and strategies for the development of the sector at the national level, as well as the formulation and execution of research projects generated at the programmatic level by INIA.
